Final Instructions

2018/2019

Please see your event details on the website to confirm the noise Limit for the day you have booked.

Only enter the circuit from the pit lane exit. ALWAYS check for other vehicles on the circuit. Obey lights or signal from pit lane marshal.

Only leave circuit at pit lane entry. Signal to do so with indicators (closed cars) or raising a hand in the air. (open cars)

Do not stop on the circuit except in the case of mechanical breakdown or instruction from a marshal. If forced to stop on the circuit or adjacent run off area, park as safely as possible.

Use hazard warning lights if fitted. Driver and passenger should then move behind the safety barriers or as instructed by a marshal.

Overtake on the LEFT ONLY (RIGHT ONLY AT CASTLE COMBE)

Overtake on the LEFT hand side (RIGHT AT CASTLE COMBE) of the vehicle being overtaken, and only on the straights. All vehicles should make frequent use their rear view mirror and be prepared to Back of the power to allow faster cars to pass in safety.

Sighting Laps.

If you leave the track (spin) etc on the sighting laps you will be asked to take no further part in the event, if you overtake on sighting lap you will also be asked to leave.

Fuel.

If you run out of Fuel on the circuit and cause a halt to track time you or your team will be charged £50.00 this will be donated to the East Anglian Air Ambulance at the end of the year.

Driver changes must take place in the Paddock.
Obey the flag / Light signals.

Yellow Lights – track hazard. SLOW DOWN! NO OVERTAKING!

Red Lights – track hazard, end of session SLOW DOWN - RETURN TO PITS.

Green Lights – Section all clear

Chequered Flag - will be held out when the session is over-

You must then complete the full lap and return to the pits.

Disciplinary Flag - (Diagonal Black and White) shown to you means you have been cautioned for irresponsible driving or breaking the rules.

Black Flag – means you MUST slow down, return to the Pits on completion of lap and report immediately to the Track Steward – either you are breaking the rules or your vehicle appears faulty

Blue lights – A faster car is behind you please allow them to pass in a safe manner.

The Two black flag rule.

Get two black flags for poor driving and you will be removed from the event.

Racing is not allowed.

Drivers seen racing will face immediate removal.

Timing of any description is expressly prohibited.

Smoking in the car or near the circuit / pit lane is prohibited (includes e cigarets)

Under no circumstances will drivers who are, or are suspected of being, under the influence of drink or drugs be allowed to participate in Track activities.

**PLEASE ALLOW FASTER CARS TO PASS - GIVE WAY SLOW
DOWN PLEASE COME OF THE POWER AS IT ALWAYS HELPS.**

FAMILIARISATION laps : you must have a helmet on to do sighting laps

These can be done in your ROAD CAR two people per car.

SPEED LIMITS –Great care must be taken in the Paddock area. Drivers manoeuvring cars will often be wearing helmets and have reduced peripheral vision. A maximum speed limit of 10 Mph must be observed at all times. A limit of 10 Mph will prevail in the pit lane.

CLOTHING- All participants must wear suitable clothing,
Arms and legs must be covered and helmets must be worn at all times when on the circuit. Helmets must be of a recognised manufacturer or complying with the current MSA general regulations as set out in section Q of those regulations.

PLEASE DO NOT HAVE MORE THAN 25 LTR'S OF FUEL IN THE GARAGE.

SEATBELTS – Must be worn at all times. 4 or 6 point harnesses are recommended for all vehicles and mandatory for race prepared cars.

PASSENGERS – All passengers must be over the age of **14** and are subject to payment of the appropriate fee (£10) and attending the Drivers Briefing. Drivers are responsible for ensuring that their passengers are aware of all the safety aspects that involve them and are compliant therewith.

TOWING EYES – All vehicles must have towing eyes fitted or be equipped with a suitable bracket to facilitate quick removal from the track in the event of a breakdown.

FUEL – PLEASE CHECK DETAILS ON OUR WEBSITE TO SEE IF IT IS AVAILABLE.

INSTRUCTION - Instructors will be in attendance at the event although their availability cannot be guaranteed. Space is on a first come first served basis, **bookable on the day first come first served PLEASE BOOK at sign on.**

Helmets

Soft top and Caterham type vehicle drivers / passengers must have full face helmets.

Hard top car drivers may have Open face helmets or Full face.

Please note we do not allow Moto X Style Helmets
